## **TABLETOP CLINIC PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

1. The objective of the Tabletop Clinic Presentations is a concise display of a single concept/technique lasting a maximum of 10 minutes so that multiple presentations can be made to small groups.
2. The Scientific Program Committee will consider the following categories for Tabletop Clinic Presentations:
  - a. Basic science and/or clinical research
  - b. Clinical applications, techniques or tips
  - c. Laboratory applications, techniques or tips
3. All applications will be reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee and will be selected based on merit and appropriateness of subject.
4. The presentation of Tabletops should be made using your personal notebook computer. The following will be provided by the ADIA for Tabletop Clinics:
  - **One draped table**
  - **Sign indicating the presenter's name(s)**
  - **No power outlet will be provided. Presenter must have fully charged batteries that will last the duration of the presentations.**
5. Commercial affiliations, with or without financial support, must be disclosed on the Tabletop Application. The ADIA discourages the use of commercial names in presentations.
6. All presentations will help to fulfill CE maintenance hours for ADIA advanced credentials.
7. Tabletop Clinic Presentations will be held during the Welcome Reception which takes place in the Exhibit Hall on Thursday, August 15, 2019 from 6:00 - 7:30 pm.
8. An appointed committee will judge all presentations. The winner of the competition will receive a complimentary one year ADIA membership, one complimentary auxiliary member registration to a future ICOI/ADIA sponsored symposium and an award plaque. The winner will be announced during the meeting.
9. The ADIA is unable to waive registration fees or provide travel/lodging expenses for Tabletop presenters. **Please make sure to register with the ICOI central office, by either faxing your registration to (973) 783-1175 or contacting the office at (973) 783-6300.**
