


MAXILLARY SINUS LIFT HANDS-ON WORKSHOP

This workshop is designed to provide to the participant a deep understanding of the available techniques for the treatment of patients with pneumatized maxillary sinuses. During the workshop, the participant, with the aid of specially designed workshop/models will be able to plan and execute various techniques for accessing the maxillary sinus cavity and manipulating the membrane for the placement of graft materials and/or simultaneous implant placement. A complication simulation will be also practiced to better understand complication solving techniques.

EXTRACTION SOCKET GRAFTING FOR IMPLANT SITE DEVELOPMENT

The long-term success of dental implants is often dependent on the quality and quantity of bone available for implant placement. Extraction socket grafting is a crucial step in implant site development and often reduces the need for additional bone grafting procedures. LASERS AROUND IMPLANTS? WHAT THE SCIENCE SAYS AND WHAT ACTUALLY HAPPENS

The debate about laser use in dentistry continues with a new focus on the treatment of peri-mucositis and peri-implantitis. The North American dental implant market was valued at 1.375 billion USD in 2020 and is expected to continue to grow 11% per year through 2028. Failing dental implants continue to be a significant issue, without a clear consensus on a best treatment approach. Today's implant clinician can leverage new research on dental lasers to maximize implant success from initial placement, and rescue failing implants with a defined protocol.

- Evaluate recently published research on bacterial reduction on titanium by various lasers in order to understand and how to select which laser wavelength for use around dental implants
- Review biological principles underlying the BLAST protocol including the practical impact on placing implants and maintaining healthy gingiva after placement
- Understand the LAPIP protocol and its place in saving a failing implant; from the retrospective studies, the prospective studies, and the actual results in clinical practice


